2017-2018 Girl Scout Badge Programs

Are you looking for a fun outdoor adventure for your Scouts? The Preserve is the perfect place to schedule a badge program for your troop!

Scout leaders need no specialized knowledge – all program content/materials provided by the Preserve. Scouts should wear appropriate clothing for outdoors (no sandals or flip flops) and for the weather & bring a reusable water bottle. *Obtaining badge patch is responsibility of Scout Troop.*

Brownie Outdoor Adventurer

Brownie Scouts will create a nature journal to record the sights and sounds they observe as they hike 1.7 mile trail around the Preserve Lake. Girls can challenge themselves to cross the swinging bridge, play an outdoor game, learn how to tie overhand and square knots and make a bird feeder to take home during this fun filled adventure. *Program length: approximately 2 – 2.5 hours*

Junior Eco Camper

During this program, Scouts will participate in activities that will enable them to plan a fun camping trip while applying the 7 principles of Leave No Trace. Scouts will learn how to choose necessary camping supplies, how to prepare a campsite and play a game that will reinforce their Leave No Trace Skills. They will also create a nature journal to record what they observe as they hike over the swinging bridge and around the lake at the Preserve. *Program length: approximately 2.5 - 3 hours*

Cadette Outdoor Art Apprentice

Scouts will hike the trail around the lake, observing nature and the varied sounds they hear from frogs to birds to wind in the trees and try to reproduce those sounds. Girls will practice their art skills through experimenting with natural dyes and use natural elements to design a fairy house to take home.

Program length: approximately 2.5 - 3 hours
